The tournament is officially regulated by the rules for the young of the **State Judo Association (HJV)** and the **German Judo Association (DJB)**. **Minimum graduation is 7th Kyu (yellow)** with the exception of U10 where it is 8th Kyu (white-yellow). Referees are made available by the organiser.



Regulations and Instructions for the Tournament

Contest Area:	Up to 6 competition areas with 5 x 5 m and/or 6 x 6 m contest area
Participants:	Admissible are all club members within the DJB, EJU or IJF, born between 1999 – 2009, from 7th Kyu (U10 from 8th Kyu), with valid Judo pass, that has to be shown at weigh in. All participants have to care about their own white/red belts.
Duration:	U10/U11/U12 m/w: 2 minutes U14/U15 m/w: 3 minutes U17/U18 m/w: 4 minutes
Awards/Medals:	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1th - 3th places receive the Olympic Style Adler-Cup medal. - Every contestant receives a certificate of participation. - The best three judo club teams/dojos each day receive a team trophy. - The best club team throughout the tournament (both days) receives the Adler-Cup-Trophy and an Apple iPad (<i>team valuation based on points: 1st = 7 pt., 2nd = 4 pt., 3rd = 2 pt., 5th = 1 pt.</i>) - There will be miscellaneous special trophies.
